

FARMHOUSE JAZZ&BLUES BAND

The band was founded in 2014 by four former members of the Stable Roof Jazz Band. The aim was to develop their own sound within Traditional Jazz, with the Chris Barber Band as their main source of inspiration.

The foundation of the band's sound lies in the rhythm section with good old Cees Heegstra on drums, Carla Tavenier-Kok on double bass, and Gerard Tavenier on guitar and banjo. A dynamic, driving trio that can just as easily accompany a sensitive ballad in a whisper-soft manner. In the frontline are trumpeter Rob van Bergen, trombonist Jan Gombert, and Wim Vreeburg on clarinet and saxophones. They provide an energetic, enthusiastic sound with well-crafted arrangements. A solid swing and plenty of drive are the basic ingredients of the sound of the band.

With this line-up, the band has managed to distinguish itself in a short time. A performance by Farmhouse is a party for young and old, where no one can remain seated and dancers are practically drawn to the dance floor! In New Orleans, the birthplace of jazz, the motto is: "Jazz is entertainment and fun" – and we couldn't agree more! The band mainly plays in the Netherlands, Germany, and Denmark.
